LYNCHBURG DISTRICT TRAFFIC ALERT Sentember 4 10, 2022

September 4-10, 2023

LYNCHBURG, Va. – Highway work requiring road/lane/structure closures is planned; however, **work may be delayed/canceled due to weather or other issues**. Items in italics contain new/updated information. For up-to-date information, call <u>511</u> or visit www.511Virginia.org.

District-wide activities:

Crews will perform various activities throughout the district to include, but are not limited to bridge & guardrail maintenance, brush/tree/limb cutting, pothole/surface/shoulder work, surface treatment/paving operations, work orders, mowing, boom axing, drainage repairs/ work and roadside cleanup.

Work at specific locations:

Amherst County:

Please note district-wide activities above.

Appomattox County:

Route 131 (Old Courthouse Rd.) from Route 460 BUS (Confederate Blvd.) to Route 460 Bypass (Richmond Highway) - Route 131 Reconstruction. Shoulder and lane closures expected. Traffic shift beginning July 12. Use caution. Estimated completion October, 2024.

Campbell County:

Route 29 North over Norfolk Southern Railroad, near LYH airport –Bridge and approach work; est. comp. end of September, 2023.

Charlotte County:

Route 15 (Farmville Highway) at Route 15/360 BUS (Four Locust Highway) - Roundabout project. Lane closures and changes to traffic patterns expected. Route 15/360 Business expected to be closed for construction beginning August 8, 2023 until approximately the end of September 2023. Message boards and detour signage will direct traffic along the detour. Estimated overall project completion October 2024.

Cumberland County:

Route 45 (Cartersville Rd.) at connection with Route 616 (Deep Run Rd.) and Route 684 (Cartersville Extension) - Paving of intersection completed. Changes in traffic pattern expected in coming weeks with conversion of intersection to a four-way stop. Please note district-wide activities above.

Halifax County:

Route 360 (James D. Hagood Highway) from Route 607 (Rodgers Chapel Rd.) to Route 92 (Clover Rd.) - Safety improvements: Shoulder widening, Rumble strips, Guardrail replacement. Lane closures expected. Estimated completion November 2023.

Route 640 (Buffalo Road) near Route 639 (Rock Barn Road) - Bridge replacement. Detour in place. Estimated completion December 2023.

Nelson County:

Route 29 North between Route 665 (Old Rose Mill Road) and Nelson County/
Albemarle County line - Milling and paving work. Watch for lane closures and work
zones

Route 60 over James River - Bridge Deck replacement. Lane closures and changes in traffic patterns. Est. comp. end of July 2024.

Pittsylvania County:

Route 750 (Strawberry Rd.) - Bridge Repairs. Route 750 (Strawberry Rd.) will be temporarily closed to through traffic from Route 813 (Glenview Rd.) to the intersection of Route 612 (Banister Rd.). This closure will run from August 28 until approximately September 8, 2023. A detour with signs has been established.

Route 601 (Hubbard Road) - Culvert Replacement. A section of Route 601 (Hubbard Road) in Pittsylvania County will close due to a culvert replacement on August 7, 2023 and remain closed until approximately September 22, 2023. A detour is in place.

Route 856 (Cobbs Knob Road) - Bridge replacement. Route 856 (Cobbs Knob Road) will be temporarily closed to through traffic from Route 622 (Cascade Road) to the intersection of Route 907 (Gerlene Lane). This closure will run from 08/14/2023 to approximately 10/06/2023.
